

Most sessions of LDC include panel discussions with Delaware County leaders who will share their leadership experiences and engage participants in discussions about trends and issues facing the County.

Leadership Delaware County runs from September to June. Through a series of ten interactive sessions led by top professionals in a variety of fields, participants develop their leadership skills while learning about their community and issues facing Delaware County. Upon completion of the program, participants will be recognized at a Graduation in May.

Established in 1989 and with more than **650 distinguished alumni**, the program lays a foundation for the importance and significance of service to the community. The FDCCC Leadership alumni hold County, State and Federal elected positions, lead non-profit organizations, corporations, or are small business owners.
